DID YOU KNOW?

- Lithium-ion batteries can overheat, catch fire, or even explode if damaged, overcharged, or used improperly.
- Fires can happen suddenly and burn extremely hot.
- These fires are difficult to extinguish and can re-ignite.



THE RISK IS REAL.

Lithium-ion batteries are in everyday items like:

-  E-scooters & E-bikes
-  Power tools
-  Cell phones & tablets
-  Laptops
-  Vape devices

If damaged or misused,
these batteries can cause
devastating fires.



SAFETY TIPS

-  **Use Only Approved Chargers**
Use the charger that came with the device or one approved by the manufacturer.
-  **Avoid Overcharging**
Unplug devices once fully charged.
Do not leave charging unattended.
-  **Inspect Batteries Regularly**
Check for swelling, damage, or leaks.
Do not use damaged batteries.
-  **Store Safely**
Keep batteries in a cool, dry place
away from flammable materials.
-  **Dispose of Properly**
Do not throw lithium-ion batteries in
the trash. Recycle at designated
collection centers.
